
BOLTON ABBEY ESCAPES

IN THE YORKSHIRE DALES

Cavendish Pavilion to Barden Bridge and return



- From Riverside car park, walk upstream past the Cavendish Pavilion and into Strid Wood.
- 2 Continue along the Green Trail upstream to the Strid.
- From the Strid bear left up to Lady Harriet's seat. One of the resting spots created by Rev. William Carr and the 6th Duke of Devonshire when they opened Strid Wood to the public in 1810. Continue up stream along the high path.
- 4 The path forks. Bear right along the riverside edge and continue to Barden Bridge.
- 5 If you wish to cut short your walk, cross the river at the Aqueduct. This ornate bridge was built to hide the pipe that carries water from Nidderdale to supply the cities of West Yorkshire.
- 6 Or continue upstream and cross at Barden Bridge.
 Follow the Orange Trail back along the river through
 Strid Wood to the Cavendish Pavilion.
